



Summer Internships Available

APPLICATION PROCESS:

DUE: Friday, April 26, 2019, midnight CST

Apply online at kinderplatz.org/internships.

OPENINGS: 3 paid summer intern positions available for college students with background in either music, visual arts, theater, dance, or early childhood education.

HOURS: 8:30 a.m.-1:30 p.m. OR noon-6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
Morning or afternoon shifts may vary week to week.

DATES: June 3-7, June 10-14, June 17-21, June 24-28, July 1-3, July 8-12, July 15-19, July 22-26, July 29-August 2
Commitment required for these nine weeks.

(* August 5-9, August 12-16, August 19-23 are also available to extend the internship for additional compensation.)

COMPENSATION: \$12.00/hour

SCOPE OF POSITION

Interns will learn about the day-to-day **imaginarium** summer art camp programs for children ages 2-6 that take place at Kinderplatz of Fine Arts. Interns will gain hands-on experience in using a variety of teaching skills through assisting KFA teachers and facilitating art projects, music, dance, theater, language arts, science and math, and outdoor nature exploration activities. At the end of the summer, under the guidance of a Lead Teacher, interns will work in teams to help plan and lead components of weeklong camp using what they have learned over the course of the internship.

LEARNING OUTCOMES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Learn about day-to-day activities of early childhood teaching, including interacting with students, parents, and staff
- Practice teaching fine arts curriculum, managing supplies, and honing class room management skills
- Learn about different learning styles, special needs, and differentiating ability levels with preschool children
- Model fine arts production/performance skills emphasizing child-centered philosophies and practices
- Discover interdisciplinary approaches to teaching the fine arts around thematic units of instruction
- Under guidance of Lead Teacher, work with 2-3 other interns to plan and lead fine arts components of a camp
- Represent Kinderplatz of Fine Arts in a professional manner and appearance, adhering to school policy and procedure

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

- Open to college students, may count as community hours or class credit, subject to school approval
- Ideal for those wishing to gain experience with fine arts education/working in an early childhood environment
- Previous experience working with children or in fine arts education is preferred
- Must be willing to promote fine arts education and the philosophy and mission of Kinderplatz of Fine Arts
